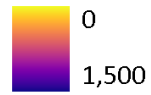

Population Density, 2020

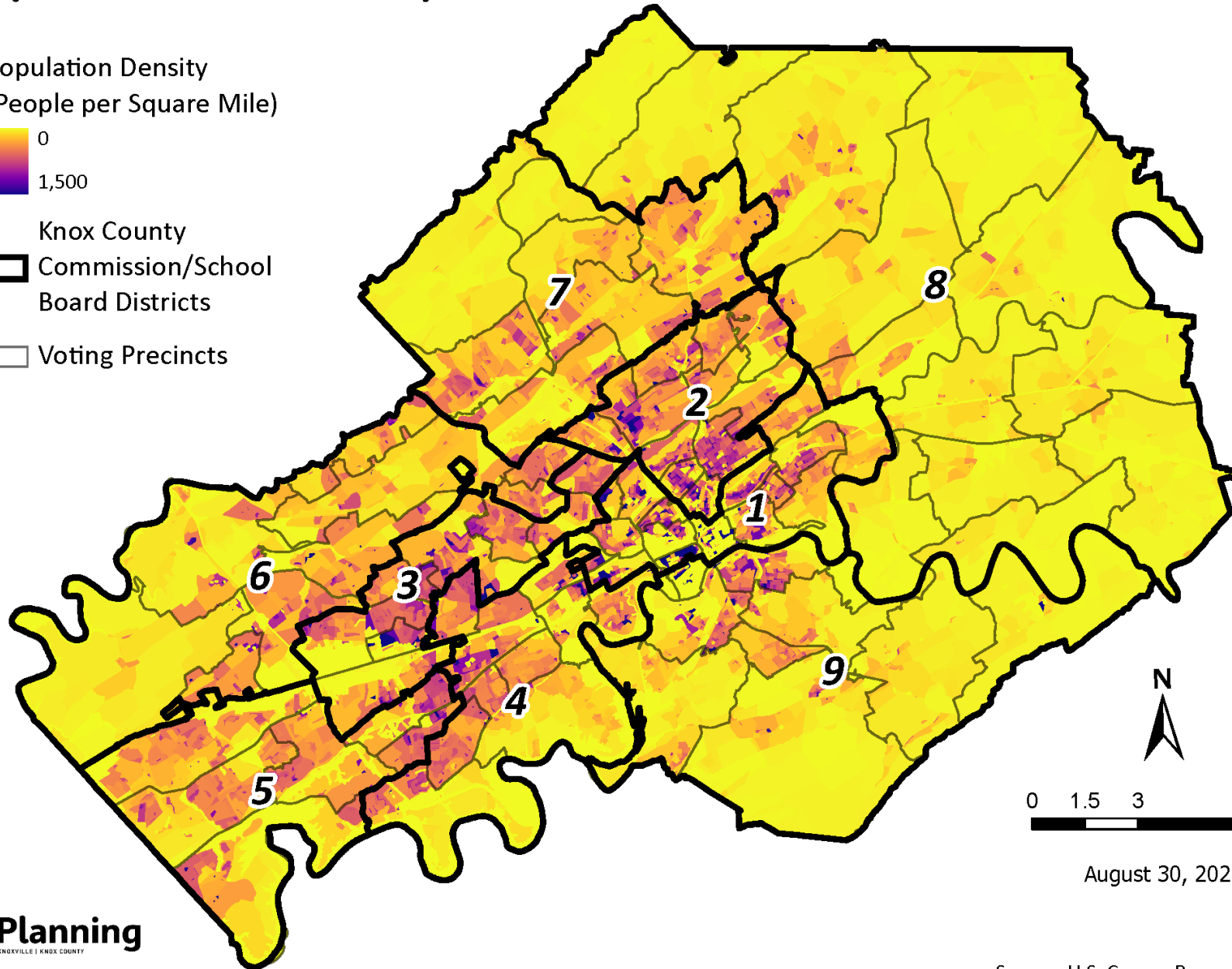
Population Density

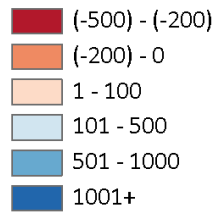

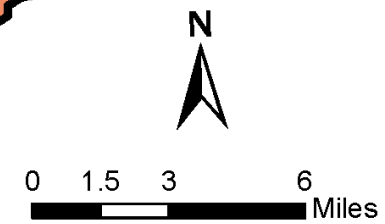
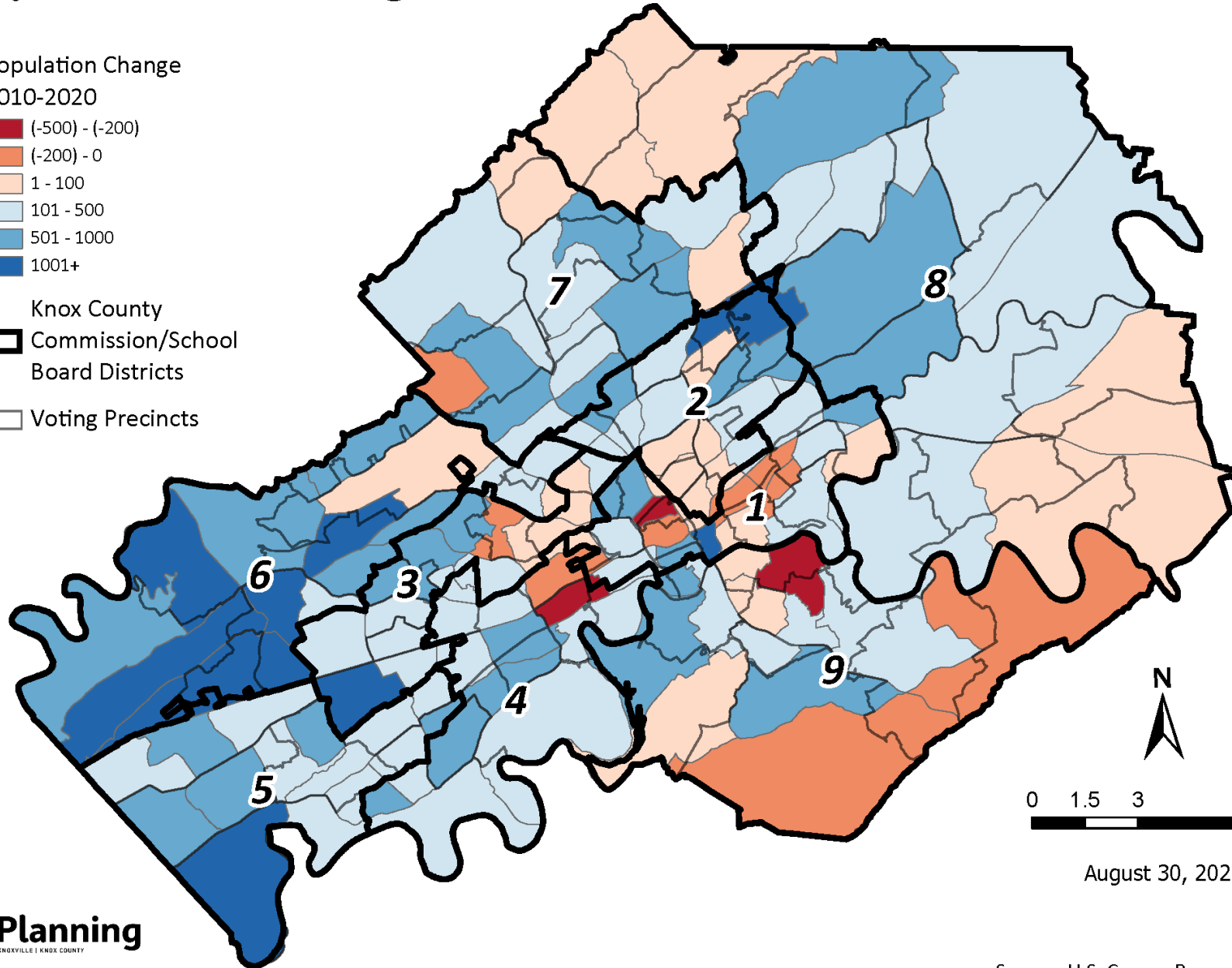


Population Change, 2010 - 2020

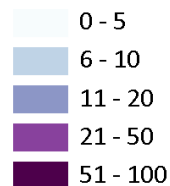

Black or African American Population, 2020

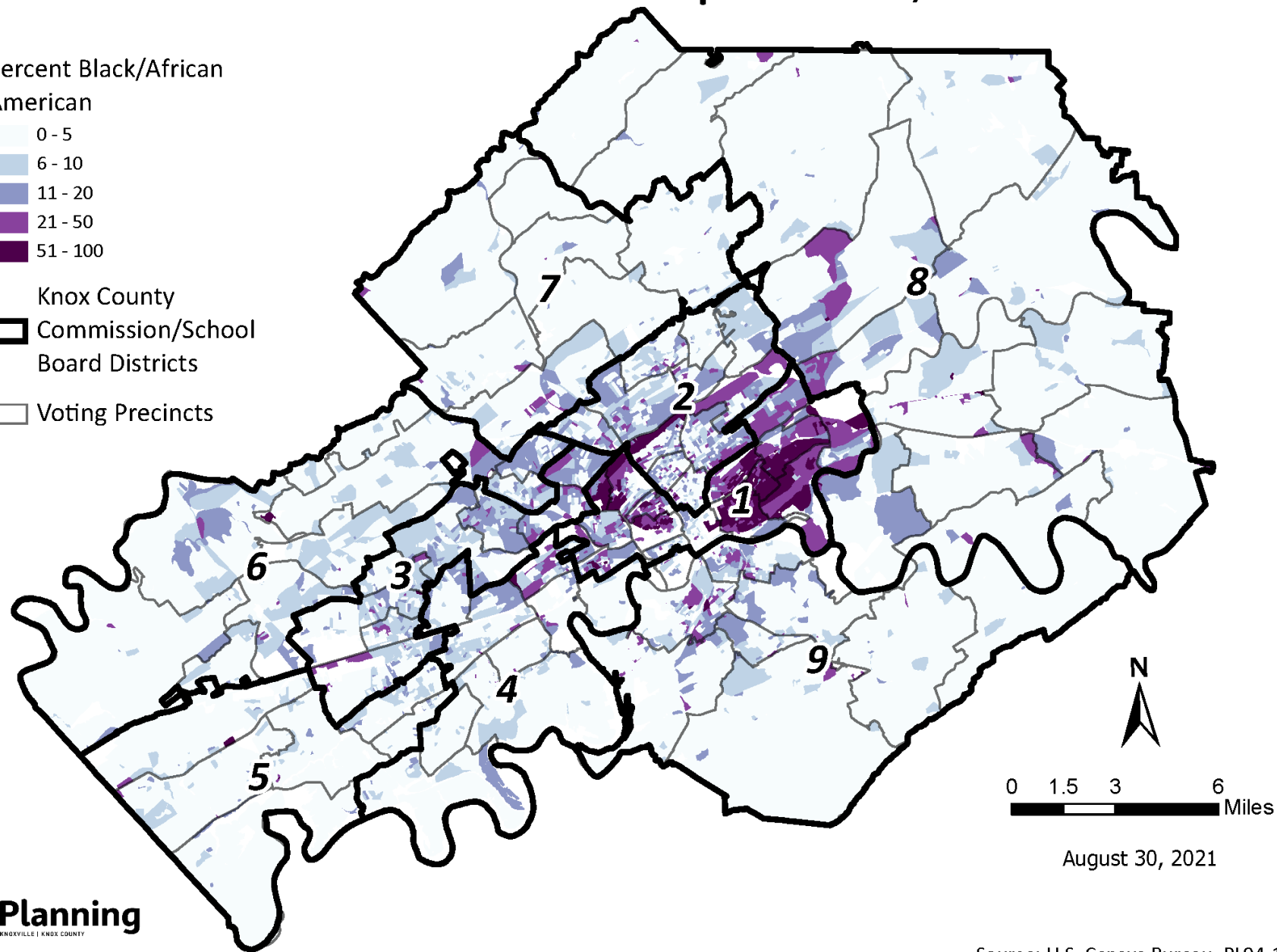
Percent Black/African American

Black or African American is largest racial-ethnic group other than white alone

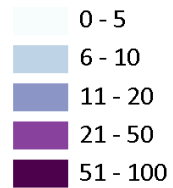
- Modest growth to 40,360, or 8.4% of the population

Black or African American Population, 2020

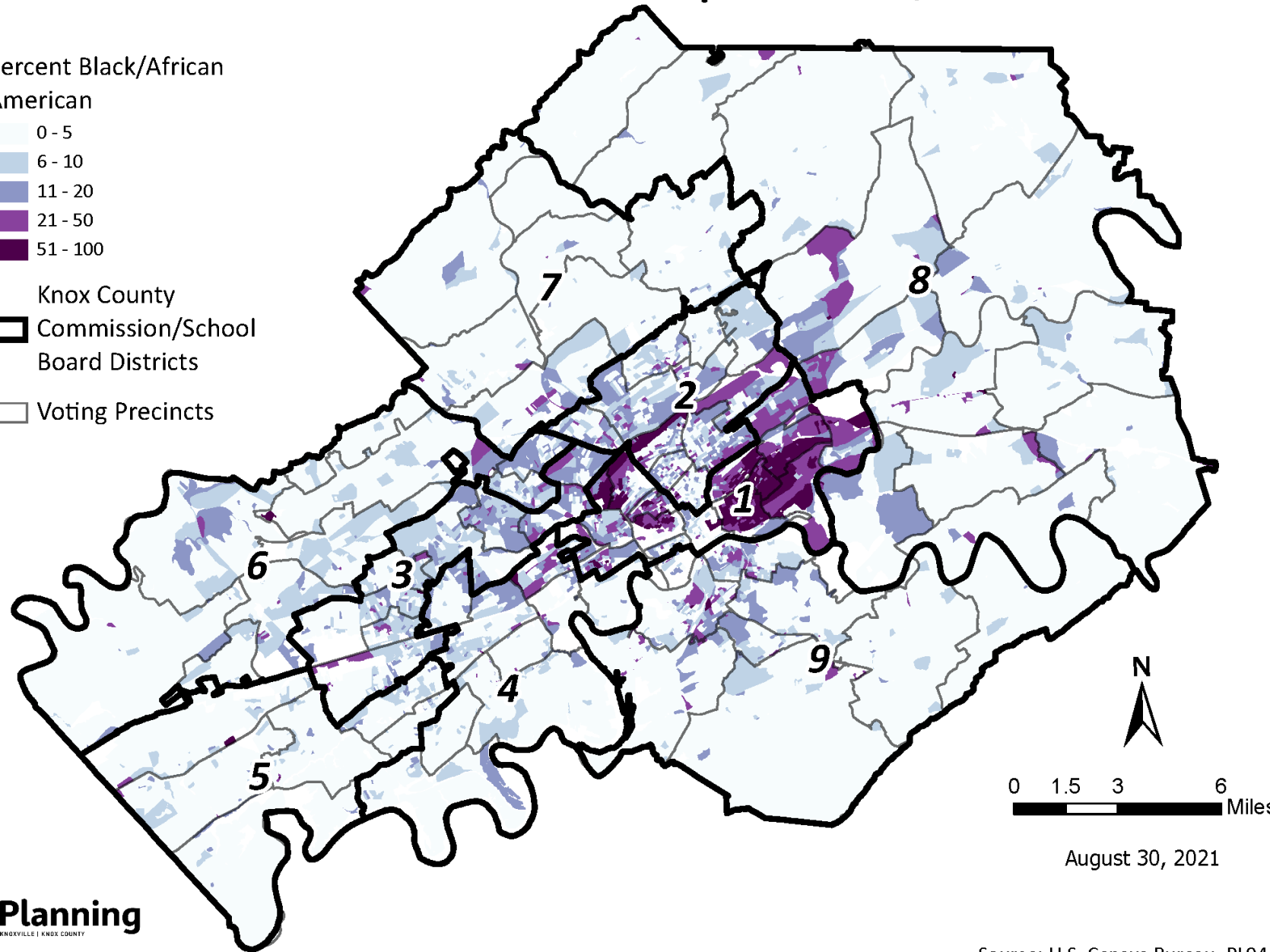
Percent Black/African American

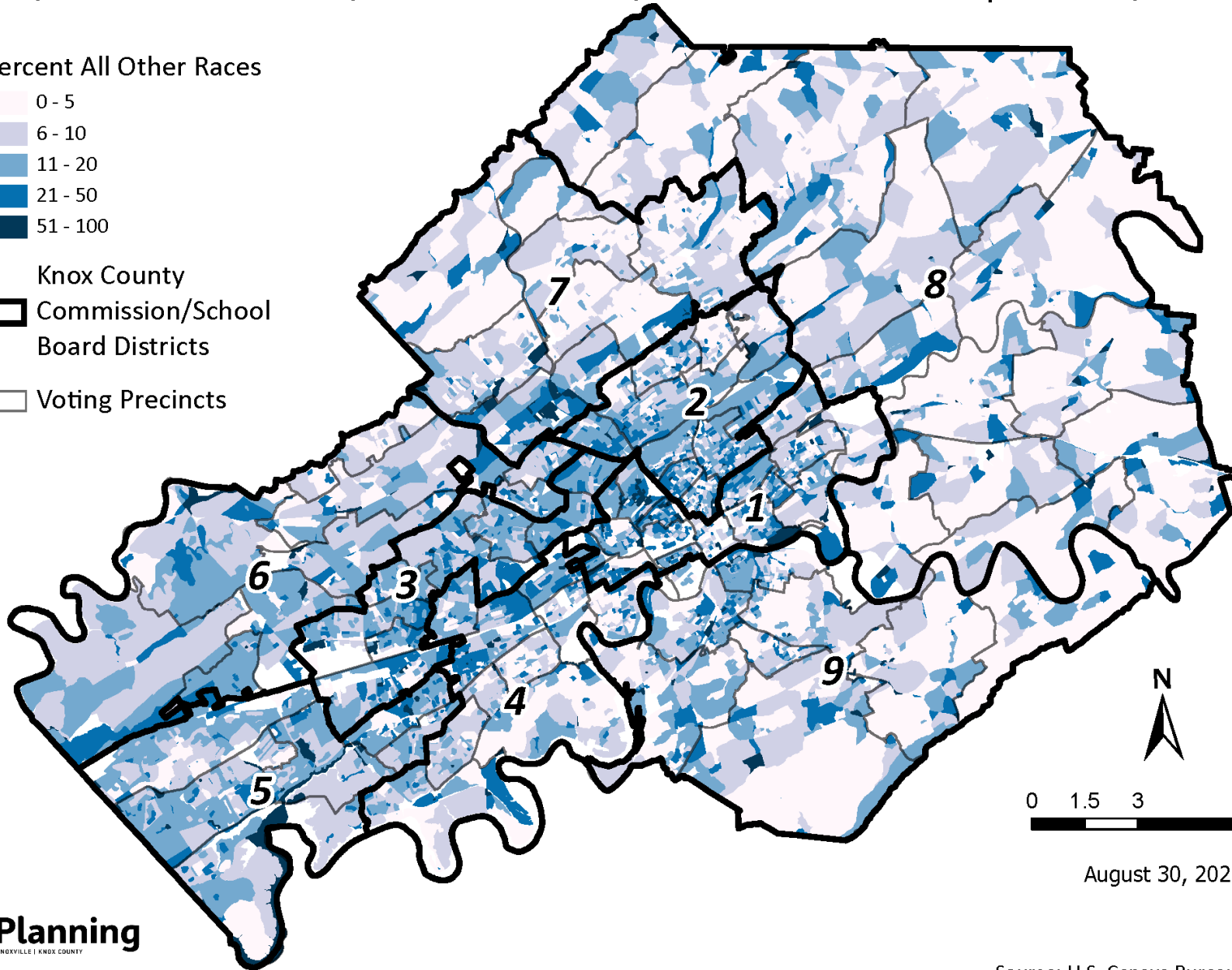
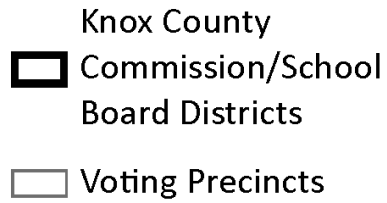
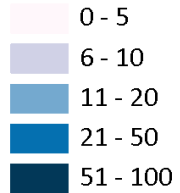


The next-largest group is the population identifying as two or more races

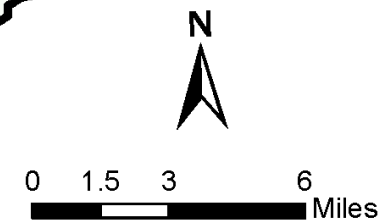

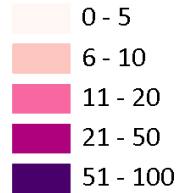

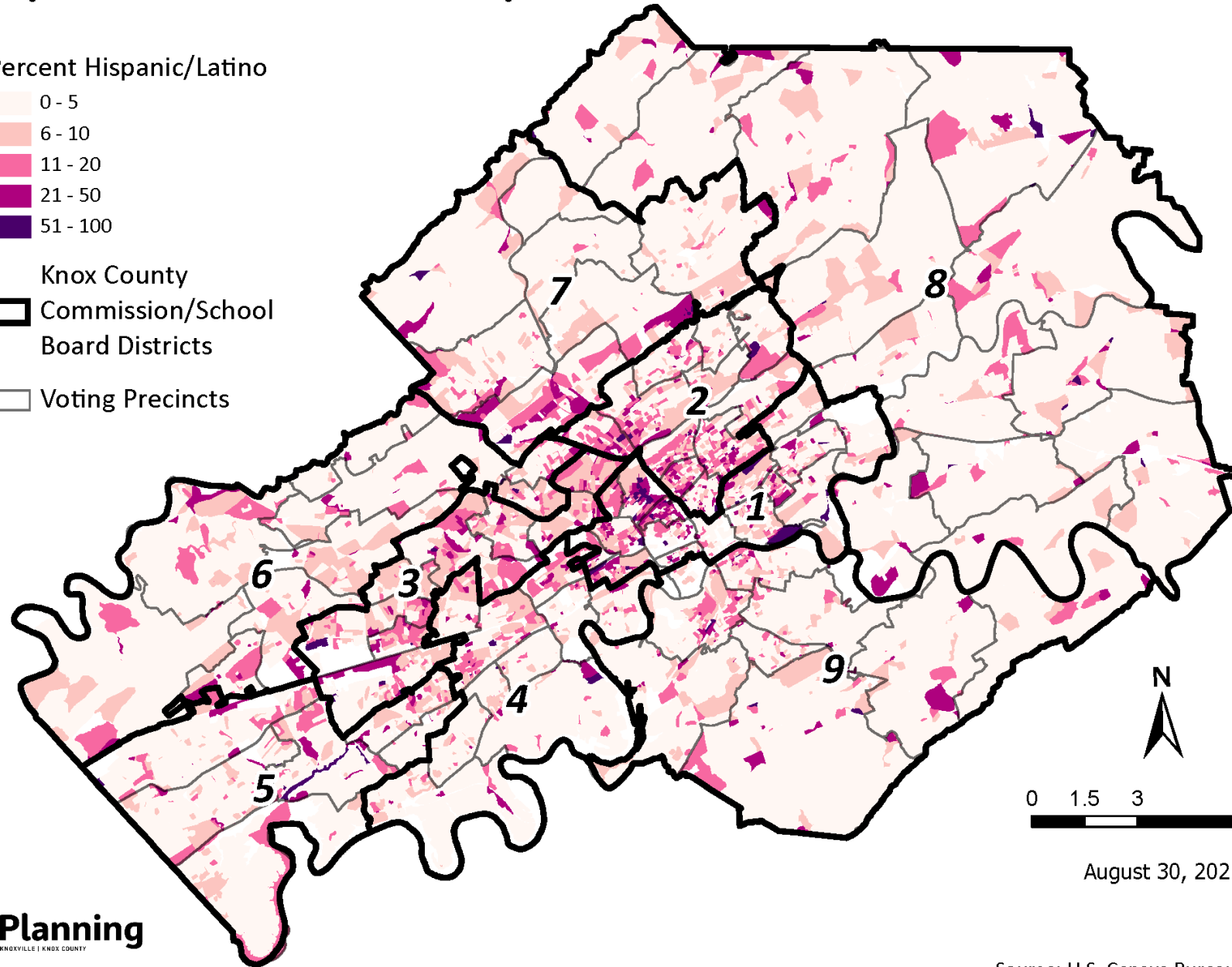
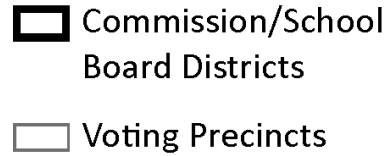

Hispanic and Latino population has also grown

- Up to 28,568 (6.0% share) in 2020 from 15,012 (3.5% share of total population) in 2010

Race and Ethnicity

The redistricting data release has made headlines because the population has been growing more diverse across the state and the nation.

The racial-ethnic minority share of the population, especially individuals who are two or more races and individuals who are Hispanic or Latino, is increasing.



Redistricting

- **Ideal Population** is the goal for each district

$$\text{Ideal Population} = \frac{\text{Total Population}}{\text{Number of Districts}}$$

$$53,095 = \frac{477,857}{9}$$

Ideal Population: 53,095



Redistricting

- **Absolute Deviation** is how far off a district is from the **Ideal Population**

Absolute Deviation = Actual Population – Ideal Population

District 1 example: $-3,783 = 49,312 - 53,095$

District 1 Absolute Deviation: -3,783

Redistricting

- **Relative Deviation** is the **Absolute Deviation** divided by the **Ideal Population** and it is expressed as a percentage

$$\text{Relative Deviation} = \frac{\text{Absolute Deviation}}{\text{Ideal Population}} \times 100$$

$$\text{District 1 example: } -7.1\% = \frac{-3,783}{53,095} \times 100$$

District 1 Relative Deviation: -7.1%



Redistricting

- The range from the smallest (or most negative) to the largest **Relative Deviation** is called the **Overall Deviation** or **Overall Range**

$$\textit{Overall Deviation} = |\textit{Smallest}| + \textit{Largest}$$

$$\textit{Overall Deviation} = |-7.1\%| + 15.5\%$$

$$22.6\% = 7.1\% + 15.5\%$$

Overall Deviation: 22.6%

Redistricting

- The goal of redistricting is to make each district have a “substantially equal population”
 - We define this as an **Overall Deviation** of less than 10%
